Excellent TCFD Disclosure Selected by GPIF's Asset Managers Entrusted with Foreign Equity Investment

Government Pension Investment Fund (GPIF) requested its external asset managers entrusted with foreign equity investment (hereinafter, "external asset manager") to nominate "excellent TCFD disclosure".

GPIF requested external asset managers to nominate up to 5 companies as "excellent TCFD disclosure" and up to 3 companies each as "excellent disclosure of (1) governance, (2) strategy, (3) risk management, and (4) metrics and targets", respectively. The result of the survey was compiled into two lists, comprised of 34 companies below selected for having excellent TCFD disclosure, and 64 companies in aggregately selected for excellent disclosure of each four TCFD disclosure shown in page 3.

[Key remarks on the "excellent TCFD disclosure" nominated by two or more external asset managers]

OBHP GROUP LTD

- BHP provides comprehensive disclosure for all 4 pillars of TCFD, and further enhanced their strategic approach to Scope 3 emissions, which is quite challenging for this industry, in its updated Climate Action Plan 2021.
- It is evaluated as a highly comprehensive climate change report, particularly with detailed assessment in target setting.

OCEMEX SAB-CPO

- Cemex's reports provide a very detailed analysis linked to its corporate strategy. Furthermore, it is backed by forward-looking targets aligned to net zero and Paris by 2050. Finally, the company delivers updated live reporting through their sustainability hub (that includes robust information related to their governance oversight, their climate action, the company's environmental & social risks and opportunities).
- Cemex is quite positive about climate change and supported TCFD in 2019 followed by integrated report in line with TCFD recommendations. In response to CDP questionnaire, CEMEX obtained A score in 2021 in the Climate Change category. The company also disclosed detailed reference sheet along with the four TCFD disclosures, increasing investors' convenience.

OENI SPA

- Clear climate strategy and reporting on progress toward goals; climate integration into overall business strategy and culture; TCFD index
- · ENI is one of the most progressive companies on climate strategy and rates well against peers.

OEQUINOR ASA

- The company is strongly committed to increasing capacity and investments in renewables and undertaking a climate transition. It has already become the world's largest offshore wind operator.
- Equinor's sustainability report is one of the most detailed within the Energy sector and substantively addresses all four pillars of the TCFD. It provides a clear picture of where the business is today, where they want to be and how they will get there. This includes a number of detailed short-, medium- and long-term targets, including Net Zero across all emission scopes by 2050.

OTAIWAN SEMICONDUCTOR MANUFACTURING CO LTD

- TSMC outline their response to TCFD in a separate report which is clearly split into the four categories. Governance charts show how different committees with a focus on climate change report up to the Board of Directors. There is also a breakdown of the responsibilities of each committee, their achievements, and members. Targets are clearly linked to management strategies.
- Comprehensive with management accountability, achievements and future targets

GPIF also requested its external asset managers entrusted with domestic equity investment to nominate "excellent TCFD disclosure" and the result was posted on its Japanese website.
